## **REVELATION 18**

In Ch. 17, we see the one world false religion which has promoted the one world gov't led by the Antichrist—now, the Antichrist is done with "her" and turns the kings of the world against her, strips her of her wealth, authority, power so that he alone will be worshipped. Revelation 18:1-24 (NIV) After this I saw another angel coming down from heaven. He had great authority, and the earth was illuminated by his splendor.

<sup>2</sup> With a mighty voice he shouted: "Fallen! Fallen is Babylon the Great! She has become a home for demons and a haunt for every evil spirit, a haunt for every unclean and detestable bird. <sup>3</sup> For all the nations have drunk the maddening wine of her adulteries. The kings of the earth committed adultery with her, and the merchants of the earth grew rich from her excessive luxuries."

Another angel---great authority—must have come from God's throne as he illuminated the earth w/his splendor! Message? Babylon the Great is fallen!

Babylon a "haunt" for evil spirits and a "haunt" for every unclean/detestable bird.

Haunt = prison! Everything about Babylon imprisons everyone/everything that it touches. The nations/kings/merchants – what is pictured here is a large prosperous city, the center of political and

economic life. With the love of money...came all sorts of greed and sinful practices. Some have erred from the faith. **ERRED = SEDUCED AWAY FROM** 

<sup>4</sup> Then I heard another voice from heaven say: "Come out of her, my people, so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues;

A voice from heaven says come out of her so you won't share in her sins...then her plagues.

Paul told the Corinthians...<sup>2</sup> Corinthians 6:14-17 (NIV) Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? <sup>15</sup> What harmony is there between Christ and Belial? What does a believer have in common with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

<sup>17</sup> "Therefore come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." Without separation, you'll eventually be drawn into their sin and away from God—becoming an object of His judgment.
 <sup>5</sup> for her sins are piled up to heaven, and God has remembered her crimes.

Sins of those in the Babylonian system, which are many, "are piled up to heaven," and God remembers them!

<sup>6</sup> Give back to her as she has given; pay her back double for what she has done. Mix her a double portion from her own cup. <sup>7</sup> Give her as much torture and grief as the glory and luxury she gave herself.

God orders that partakers of this Babylonian system will be paid back double for what they've done. Elisha asked for a double portion of the Spirit that was on Elijah.

Here, sinners will be rewarded with a double portion of torture & grief as the glory & luxury she gave herself. V7—Christians should use wealth to meet the needs of a desperate world, not for self-glorying and indulgence.

**Proverbs 14:31 (NIV)** He who oppresses the poor shows contempt for their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy honors God.


**1 John 3:16-18** "This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

**1** John 3:17 [KJV] "But whosoever has this world's good, and sees his brother have need, and shuts up his <u>bowels</u> of compassion from him, how dwells the love of God in him?"

Bowels of compassion – Gk word splanchnon A strengthened form or our word spleen.

Your spleen is often on the "front lines" of your body; It acts as a filter for your blood. It recognizes and removes old, malformed, or damaged red blood cells. When blood flows into your spleen, your spleen performs "quality control" as your red blood cells pass through a maze of narrow passages. Healthy blood cells simply pass through the spleen and continue to circulate throughout your bloodstream. Blood cells that can't pass the test will be broken down in your spleen large white blood cells that specialize in destroying these unhealthy red blood cells. Your spleen saves any useful components from the old cells, such as iron. It stores iron and eventually returns the iron to your bone marrow, where hemoglobin is made. Hemoglobin is an important protein in your blood that transports oxygen from your lungs to all the parts of your body that need it. Your spleen also plays an important part in your immune system, which helps your body fight infection.

Finaly, another useful purpose of your spleen is storing blood. The blood vessels in human spleens are able to get wider or narrower, depending on your body's needs. When vessels are expanded, your spleen can actually hold up to a cup of reserve blood. If for any reason you need some extra blood – for example, if trauma causes you to lose blood – your spleen can respond by releasing that reserve blood back into your system.

So...if your spleen is "shut up," there is no filter for old/malformed/damages red blood cells (junk gets through), the good parts, such as iron does not get to your bone marrow (strengthen your bones), and you could lack oxygen in parts of your body. Also, your immune system is weakened, and extra blood which you might need at some time is unable to be stored. The physical benefit of the spleen, parallel's the spiritual benefit as we open up our "bowels of compassion" to those in need!

<mark>Jesus said the</mark> Pharisees had a problem because their spiritual eyes were diseased (v.22). With their eyes they were coveting money and wealth. Thus, they were in spiritual darkness. <mark>They were</mark> slaves to the master of greed, and

their desire for money was so great they were failing in their service to their true Master, God. Money is the translation of the Aramaic word for "wealth or property," *mamōna* ("mammon," kjv).

Giving and generosity is the way to combat the spirit of greed.

poured through a hole in the center of the rotating millstone, flowing into shallow grooves, called channels, which radiate from the center of the stationary millstone. The channels lead the grain onto the flat grinding section, called the land, and to the edge,

Researching it, he says a millstone 53" in diameter, 8" thick, with a 13" square hole would be 1500 pounds!
